

By Mr. Weekes of Harwich, petition of Stephen Weekes that the Department of Public Works be authorized to participate with the federal government in the town of Harwich in certain navigation projects in the Andrews River area of said town. Harbors and Public Works.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH TO PARTICIPATE WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN THE TOWN OF HARWICH IN CERTAIN NAVIGATION PROJECTS IN THE ANDREWS RIVER AREA OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works, subject to
2 appropriation, is hereby authorized to pay to the Secretary
3 of the Army on his demand, the contribution required, if any,
4 from local interests, as specified by the Congress of the United
5 States with respect to a project in the Andrews river area of
6 South Harwich, authorized by the River and Harbor Acts
7 of 1960 and 1962 and Public Law 71, 84th Congress, and to
8 give to said Secretary of the Army the assurances required for
9 this project; provided, that the town of Harwich shall have
10 deposited with the state treasurer one half of such contribution
11 and assumed liability, in the manner provided by section twenty-
12 nine of chapter ninety-one of the General Laws, for all damages
13 that may be incurred under said project, and have given to said
14 department of public works satisfactory assurances that condi-
15 tions imposed upon them with respect to such project will be
16 met.

1 SECTION 2. Any sums borrowed by the town of Harwich
2 pursuant to section three of chapter five hundred and forty-one
3 of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-four may be used for
4 the purpose of meeting the payments required to be made by it
5 under section one of this act.
