By Mr. Carney of Boston, petition of Daniel W. Carney for legislation to increase the fee for a license to operate a motor vehicle or for the renewal thereof. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT INCREASING THE FEE FOR A LICENSE TO OPERATE MOTOR VEHICLES, OR FOR THE RENEWAL THEREOF.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by section 13 of chapter 679 of the acts of 1965,  
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the eighth and ninth  
4 paragraphs following subdivision (7) and inserting in place  
5 thereof the following paragraphs:—

6 For every license to operate motor vehicles, or for the renewal  
7 thereof, six dollars, less one dollar and fifty cents if the license  
8 period is less than eighteen calendar months.

9 For every renewal of any license to operate motor vehicles,  
10 six dollars, but if the renewal period is one full year or less, the  
11 fee shall be two dollars and fifty cents. No fee shall be collected  
12 for a license or renewal thereof restricted to the operation of  
13 motor-propelled fire apparatus only.
