AN ACT TO PROVIDE BENEFITS AFTER A PERIOD IN A LABOR DISPUTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of subsection (b) of chapter 151A of
2 the General Laws, is hereby amended by the insertion of the
3 following Item (3) after the word "dispute" appearing in
4 Item (2) of said paragraph: — or (3) after six weeks follow-
5 ing the commencement of a labor dispute work stoppage if
6 the director finds that the employer involved in the labor
7 dispute has refused to submit the issues involved in the
8 dispute to arbitration or has locked out the employees; .
