## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO THE TOWN OF BROOKLINE OF CERTAIN MONEYS OVERPAID TO THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The metropolitan district commission is authorized and  
2 directed to pay to the town of Brookline the sum of twelve  
3 thousand, two hundred seventy-nine dollars and fifty-four cents,  
4 to reimburse said town for sums overpaid by it to said commis-  
5 sion in assessments for serial bond interest and principal under  
6 the provisions of chapter two hundred and thirty of the acts  
7 of nineteen hundred and sixty-one (General Laws, chapter  
8 ninety-two, section five A, as amended) for the years nineteen  
9 hundred and sixty-one, nineteen hundred and sixty-two, nine-  
10 teen hundred and sixty-three, nineteen hundred and sixty-four  
11 and nineteen hundred and sixty-five by reason of said commis-  
12 sion including in the computation of the said yearly assess-  
13 ments an eight-inch connection to the metropolitan district  
14 commission trunk sewer, formerly serving the Brookline Hills  
15 Railroad station, which connection had in fact been discontinued  
16 in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
