In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT REQUIRING PERSONS HOLDING ANY PUBLIC OFFICE TO AFFIRM THAT SAID PERSONS ARE NOT COMMUNISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 14 of chapter 264 of the General Laws, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following
3 paragraph: —

4 I further swear (or affirm) that I am not a Communist,
5 nor am I a member of any other organization engaged in
6 subversive activities.
