AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWNS OF SCITUATE, NORWELL, HULL AND MARSHFIELD TO WITHDRAW FROM THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law, general or special,
2 to the contrary, the towns of Scituate, Norwell, Hull and
3 Marshfield are hereby authorized to withdraw from the Massa-
4 chusetts Bay Transportation Authority system.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect in any of the aforesaid
2 towns upon its acceptance by said town.
