## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO RECORDING CERTAIN PLANS OF TRACTS OF LAND IN A REGISTRY OF DEEDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section SIX of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 313 of the acts of 1962, is hereby  
3 further amended by adding at the end thereof the following  
4 paragraph:—

5 Such register or recorder shall accept for record a plan of  
6 land upon which is endorsed the statement that the plan is to  
7 be recorded for purposes not related to the subdivision control  
8 and the recording thereof does not confer any rights with  
9 relation thereto; notwithstanding that said plan does not  
10 comply otherwise with the provisions of this section. The  
11 recording of such plan as so endorsed shall not confer any  
12 rights under the subdivision control law.
