AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN CERTAIN RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN THE CASTLE ISLAND SECTION OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to construct, care for, and maintain a "Tot Lot",
- 3 so-called, in the Castle Island section of the city of Boston.
