AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO IMPROVE CERTAIN BEACHES IN THE METROPOLITAN PARKS DISTRICT, AND MAINTAIN CONTINUING PROJECTS TO PROTECTION FROM EROSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to improve all the metropolitan parks district  
3 beaches in the sixth and seventh wards of the city of Boston by  
4 re-sanding, and thereafter to adopt a policy of continuing  
5 maintenance, improvement, stabilization and protection from  
6 erosion in respect of said beaches.

By the Clerk of the House, ordered that the bill be printed and the same be distributed to the members of the House.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATUTES RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF DEEDS.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Conference on the 10th day of February, 1837.

1. The registration clerk's commission shall be renewed every year, and he shall be required to deposit all the moneys he receives in the treasury of the State, and to render an account thereof to the next session of the Legislature.
