AN ACT ALLOWING PART TIME EMPLOYMENT BY RETIRED EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding after the last sentence: — notwithstanding
3 any provisions of this act a person who has reached mandatory
4 retirement age may accept part time employment from the
5 commonwealth or one of its subdivisions provided that the re-
6 muneratation from such position plus his pension equals no
7 more than the salary he was receiving when he reached mand-
8 atory retirement age. Such part time employment shall not in
9 any way affect the pension or retirement allowance payable to
10 such employee.
