AN ACT TO DESIGNATE MAY TWENTY-NINTH AS A LEGAL HOLIDAY TO  
BE KNOWN AS PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY'S BIRTHDAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Clause Eighteenth of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General  
2 Laws<sup>1</sup> is hereby amended by inserting after the words "April  
3 nineteenth" the words: — May twenty-ninth.
