The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT RELIEVING THE CITY OF LOWELL OF PAYMENT OF ANY SUMS OF MONEY TO THE COMMONWEALTH FOR CHARGES OF THE LOWELL TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law
2 to the contrary, the city of Lowell shall not be required to pay
3 any sums of money to the commonwealth as part of the charges
4 of the Lowell Technological Institute.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
