By Mr. Hollis of Braintree, petition of Herbert B. Hollis relative to the fee for the registration of boat trailers. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FEE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF BOAT TRAILERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out subdivision (5), as appearing in section 12 of
3 chapter 679 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following subdivision:— (5) For the registration of every
5 trailer, except a boat trailer, for which a fee is not otherwise
6 provided in this section, six dollars for every one thousand
7 pounds or fraction thereof of the weight of such trailer and
8 the maximum load to be carried thereon. For the registration
9 of a boat trailer, three dollars.
