AN ACT REQUIRING NOTIFICATION BY REGISTERED MAIL OF THE  
DECLARATION OF DIVIDENDS ON CERTAIN EXPIRED POLICIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 The last paragraph of section 80 of chapter 175 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 317 of the acts of 1947, is hereby  
3 amended by inserting after the word "address", in line 3, the  
4 words: — by registered mail.
