AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A FULLY ENCLOSED ICE SKATING RINK IN THE TOWN OF ARLINGTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to construct and maintain a fully enclosed ice  
3 skating rink in the town of Arlington. For this purpose said  
4 commission shall expend such sums as may be appropriated  
5 therefor.
