AN ACT RELATIVE TO REGULATION OF FEES FOR BARBERING AND THE ELIMINATION OF A PORTION OF THE EXAMINATION FOR NATIVES OF FOREIGN LANDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 87H of chap-  
2 ter 112 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by  
3 chapter 490 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further amended  
4 by striking out the third sentence and inserting in place  
5 thereof the following sentence:—

6 Any person holding a certificate or renewal certificate which  
7 has expired may have such certificate or renewal certificate  
8 reinstated within one year of the date of expiration upon the  
9 payment of a fee of ten dollars.

1 SECTION 2. Section 87I of said chapter 112, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 292 of the acts of 1958, is hereby  
3 further amended by inserting after the third sentence the  
4 following sentences:—Each applicant for examination shall  
5 pay a fee of ten dollars which shall accompany his applica-  
6 tion; for each subsequent examination he shall pay a fee  
7 of five dollars but no applicant shall be eligible to take more  
8 than two examinations in a period of less than six months.  
9 An applicant for a permit who is not a native of the United  
10 States shall be required to take the practical portion of the  
11 examination only.
