AN ACT PROHIBITING THE TRANSFER OF EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS WITHOUT EMPLOYEE'S CONSENT AND RELATING TO HIS TRAVEL EXPENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No employee of the commonwealth, employed by the depart-
2 ment of public works, shall be transferred from the area or dis-
3 trict of his permanent residence, without the employee's con-
4 sent or approval.

5 If the employee consents or approves of a transfer from such
6 area or district, he shall be paid travel and per diem expenses
7 originating from his home.
