AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CO-OPERATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAMS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 28A of chapter 7 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph thereof.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 59 the following section:—

3 *Section 60.* The director of the bureau of personnel shall
4 cooperate with public and private colleges and universities
5 and other institutions of higher education that are degree
6 granting and that provide facilities for educating their stu-
7 dents on the so-called "co-operative plan" of education by de-
8 veloping and maintaining work-study programs whereby the
9 students thus enrolled may be employed in the service of the
10 commonwealth in positions that are appropriate to their major
11 academic interests. The employment of such students in posi-
12 tions classified under section forty-five shall be approved by the
13 director of the bureau of personnel and shall otherwise be
14 exempt from chapter thirty-one and the rules and regulations
15 made under said chapter, upon certification to the director of
16 civil service by a representative of the college, university or
17 institution in which the individual is enrolled as a student
18 under a "co-operative plan" of education provided that the
19 student's employment by the commonwealth under such plan
20 is for a stated and limited time.
