- 2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 285
- 3 of the acts of 1964, is hereby further amended by striking out, in
- 4 line 16 and 17, as appearing in chapter 384 of the acts of 1956,
- 5 the words "and which is the place of his domicile".
