AN ACT RELATIVE TO "SCHOOL TRAFFIC SUPERVISORS".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 31 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out, in line 28, as appearing in
3 chapter 162 of the acts of 1963, the words "male school traf-
4 fic supervisors, or male employees" and inserting in place
5 thereof the words: — school traffic supervisors, or persons.

1 SECTION 2. Section two of chapter one hundred and sixty-
2 two of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-three is hereby
3 repealed.
