AN ACT INCREASING THE STATE SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION GRANTS FOR CITIES AND TOWNS IN DEPRESSED AREAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (a) of section 9 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948,
2 as amended by section 1 of chapter 467 of the acts of 1963,
3 is hereby further amended by adding at the end the follow-
4 ing: — ; and provided, further, that the grant for any city
5 or town which has been designated as a depressed area by
6 the department of commerce and development or which has
7 an unemployment rate above the national average shall be
8 fifty per cent of such approved cost.
