RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ALL ASPECTS OF THE RATES FOR COMPULSORY MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-
3 tatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study of all aspects of the rates for compulsory motor
6 vehicle insurance, the reasons for the continued increase in
7 the same, the methods of establishing the rate, and all other
8 matters relative thereto which the commission deems reason-
9 able and proper. Said commission shall have the power to
10 summon witnesses and to require the production of books,
11 records and papers as it deems necessary.
