AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE POSSESSION AND CONTROL OF NARCOTIC DRUGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 94 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 209A the following section:—
- 3 *Section 209B.* Any person lawfully in possession of any
- 4 narcotic drug, who leaves the same in an unattended motor
- 5 vehicle shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty
- 6 dollars and not more than one thousand dollars.
