AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF UNIFORM PROBATE FORMS THROUGHOUT THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 215 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 50 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 50A.* All probate court forms shall be uniform
- 4 throughout the commonwealth. Blank spaces shall be left
- 5 on all such forms so as to leave space for the insertion of
- 6 the name of the county in which the form is to be filed and
- 7 the name of the court and judge and register where necessary.
