AN ACT TO RELOCATE CERTAIN LINES BY ELECTRIC LIGHT COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 166 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 21 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 21A.* The electric light companies are hereby di-
- 4 rected to start a program of rehabilitation in Massachusetts
- 5 cities and towns of over fifty thousand population by placing
- 6 underground at least five hundred house feeds per year at no
- 7 cost to the ultimate subscriber.
