**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

AN ACT LIMITING THE FEE TO BE CHARGED BY A MANAGER OF A  
BOXER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 147 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 43, as appearing in the Tercentenary  
3 Edition, the following section: —

4 *Section 43A.* No contract shall be valid between a boxer  
5 and his manager which shall contain a provision granting to  
6 the manager as his fee an amount in excess of ten per centum  
7 of the amount of the purse received by said boxer for his  
8 services.

The Government of Pennsylvania

Act of the General Assembly

Approved by the Governor and the Senate

Effective from and after the date of its passage

1. That the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall have the honor and duty to call the General Assembly together at the time and place specified in the Constitution.
2. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the laws of this Commonwealth are faithfully executed.
3. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the public lands of this Commonwealth are properly managed.
4. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the public debt of this Commonwealth is properly managed.
5. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the public works of this Commonwealth are properly managed.
6. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the public buildings of this Commonwealth are properly managed.
7. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the public parks of this Commonwealth are properly managed.
8. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the public libraries of this Commonwealth are properly managed.
9. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the public schools of this Commonwealth are properly managed.
10. That the Governor shall have the honor and duty to see that the public hospitals of this Commonwealth are properly managed.
