The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE BOSTON REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY SHALL BE GOVERNED BY STATE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 any proceedings before the Boston Redevelopment Authority
- 3 shall be governed by chapter thirty A of the General Laws.
