AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY OF REVERE TO HAVE JOINT MONTHLY MEETINGS OF THE MAYOR, CITY COUNCIL, SCHOOL COMMITTEE AND SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, the city of Revere is hereby authorized and di-
3 rected to hold joint monthly meetings of the mayor, city coun-
4 cil, school committee and superintendent of schools.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 by the city of Revere.
