AN ACT EXTENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONAL APPOINTMENTS AND TEMPORARY TRANSFERS FOR A LIMITED PERIOD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 7 of chapter 743 of the acts of 1962, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 510 of the acts of 1965, is hereby further
3 amended by crossing out said section 7 and inserting in place
4 thereof the following:

5 *Section 7.* Sections four, five and six of this act shall cease
6 to be effective on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and sixty-
7 seven; provided, that in any office or position in the common-
8 wealth or any agency or political subdivision thereof where
9 compliance with the Federal standards for a merit system of
10 personnel administration is a condition for the granting of
11 Federal funds, the examination shall be held within a year
12 from the date of the approval of any provisional authoriza-
13 tion or temporary transfer.
