RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING A UNIFORM SET OF RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF SCHOOL BUSES THROUGHOUT THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of the reg-
2 istrar of motor vehicles or his designee, the commissioner of
3 public safety or his designee, the commissioner of education or
4 his designee, a superintendent of public schools to be designated
5 by the commissioner of education, and a chief of police to be
6 designated by the President of the Massachusetts Chiefs' of
7 Police Association, is hereby established for the purpose of
8 making an investigation and study of developing a uniform
9 set of rules and regulations relative to the operation of school
10 buses on the public ways of the commonwealth so as to increase
11 the safety of children boarding, riding or alighting from same.
