AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO SELL AND CONVEY LAND IN THE VICINITY OF SHIP AVENUE AND MYSTIC RIVER IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD TO THE MEDFORD LODGE SONS OF ITALY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to sell and convey to the Medford Lodge Sons of
- 3 Italy fifty thousand square feet of land in the vicinity of Ship
- 4 avenue and Mystic river in the city of Medford for the sum of
- 5 two thousand dollars.
