## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

### AN ACT GRANTING THE CONSENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO A PETITION BY JULIA J. PIERCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Julia J. Pierce of Lynn is hereby authorized, within six  
2 months after the passage of this act, to bring a petition  
3 against the commonwealth under the provisions of chapter  
4 two hundred and fifty-eight of the General Laws that the  
5 court determine whether, in the manner and subject to the  
6 limitations, conditions and restrictions specified in section  
7 fifteen of chapter eighty-four of the General Laws, but not  
8 including the requirements relative to a written notice as  
9 specified in sections eighteen and nineteen of said chapter  
10 eighty-four, injuries sustained by her on or about June fourth,  
11 nineteen hundred and sixty-five, were caused by a defect or  
12 want of repair of a way at the Franklin Park Zoo in Boston  
13 under the control of the metropolitan district commission and,  
14 if the court shall so determine, to find the amount of her  
15 damages, which should not, however, exceed three thousand  
16 dollars.
