AN ACT SETTING APART MARCH SEVENTH, NINETEEN SIXTY-SIX AS  
SPEAKER JOHN W. MCCORMACK DAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

- 1 The governor shall issue a proclamation setting apart March  
2 seventh, nineteen sixty-six as Speaker John W. McCormack  
3 Day. Said proclamation shall recommend that said day be  
4 observed with ceremonies appropriated thereto.
