

HOUSE No. 2433

By Mr. Flannery of Taunton, petition of Charles L. Flannery relative to forbidding a person changing his party enrollment from being a candidate for nomination for certain offices after a certain date. Election Laws.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO FORBIDDING A PERSON CHANGING HIS PARTY ENROLLMENT FROM BEING A CANDIDATE FOR NOMINATION FOR CERTAIN OFFICES AFTER A CERTAIN DATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 48 of chapter 53 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the last sen-
3 tence added by chapter 254 of the acts of 1965 and inserting
4 in place thereof the following sentence:—No such certificate
5 shall be issued to any person who is a candidate for nomination
6 for any such office, if such person has changed his party enroll-
7 ment after January first in the year prior to the last day for
8 filing nomination papers with the state secretary as provided
9 by this section.
