By Mr. Harrison of Gloucester, petition of David E. Harrison for legislation relative to the transportation or dumping of dredge materials in tide waters. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OR DUMPING OF DREDGE MATERIALS IN TIDE WATERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 52 of chapter 91 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof
3 the following sentence:— The department shall supervise the
4 transportation or dumping of all materials dredged in the tide
5 waters of the commonwealth, or of any other material which may
6 be placed in scows or boats to be transported or dumped in tide
7 water, and may employ necessary inspectors therefor, who shall
8 accompany the material while in transit, either upon the scows
9 containing the material or upon the boat towing them, upon
10 which they shall be provided with proper and suitable quarters
11 and board by the owner of the boat.
