### AN ACT INCREASING PAYMENTS FOR BODILY DISFIGUREMENT UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 36 of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 471 of the acts of 1962, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out subsection (h) and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following subsection: —

5 (h) For bodily disfigurement the number of weeks which,  
6 according to the determination of the industrial accident board,  
7 reviewing board or single member, is a proper and equitable  
8 compensation, not to exceed four hundred weeks, which sum  
9 shall be payable in addition to all other sums under this section  
10 wherever the same shall be applicable.
