RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO LODGING HOUSES IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-
2 bers of the senate, three members of the house of representatives,
3 and five persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby es-
4 tablished for the purpose of making an investigation and study
5 relative to the operation and management of lodging houses in
6 the city of Boston. Said commission shall consider the impact
7 which student living in lodging houses has had on the proper
8 control, maintenance and operation thereof and shall also con-
9 sider the advisability and feasibility of the licensing authorities
10 permitting cooking in the rooms of lodging houses under proper
11 safety precautions.
