RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF REGISTERING AUTOMOBILE MANUFACTURERS, THEIR DISTRIBUTORS AND DEALERS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, the registrar of motor vehicles or his designee, and
4 three persons to be appointed by the governor, one of whom
5 shall be a representative of the Massachusetts State Automobile
6 Association, Inc. and one of whom shall be a representative of
7 the Automobile Manufacturers Association, is hereby estab-
8 lished for the purpose of making an investigation and study
9 relative to the feasibility of registering automobile manufac-
10 turers, their distributors and dealers. Said commission may
11 travel without the commonwealth.
