AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN CONTRACTS REQUIRING DECISIONS BY AWARDING AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 44A of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the first sentence the following
3 sentence:— Every contract for the construction, reconstruc-
4 tion, alteration, remodeling, repair, or demolition, requiring de-
5 cisions to be made by the awarding authority, their agents, or
6 employees shall contain a provision requiring that such de-
7 cisions be made in writing within two days after request has
8 been made in writing for same.
