## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PERSONS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OVER SHALL NOT BE TAXED ON CERTAIN UNEARNED INCOME.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to  
2 the contrary, a person age sixty-five or more who receives a  
3 total income in an amount of not more than four thousand dol-  
4 lars per year shall not be taxed on whatever portion of that  
5 amount is unearned.
