AN ACT INCLUDING CERTAIN SHIPS AND VESSELS WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF A COMMON CARRIER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 159A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 1 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 1A.* The term common carriers, as herein referred,
- 4 shall also mean and include ships and vessels in excess of one
- 5 hundred gross tons, using steam or diesel engine as means of
- 6 propulsion, transporting passengers between points within
- 7 the commonwealth.
