RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES RELATIVE TO THE EFFECT OF LIGHTING OF SIGNS AND COMMERCIAL AND OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS ALONG TRAVELLED WAYS.

1 *Resolved*, That the registrar of motor vehicles is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to the effect of lighting of signs and of commercial and
4 other establishments along travelled ways with a view toward
5 determining what kind and intensity of light may effect high-
6 way safety.

7 Said registrar may expend for consultants, clerical and other
8 assistance and for expenses such sums as may be appropriated
9 therefor.

10 Said registrar shall report to the general court the results
11 of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,
12 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
13 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
14 of the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday
15 of December in the current year.
