AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF FRANKLIN AND PROVIDING THAT HE SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES AND INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF SAID COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 77A of chap-
2 ter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 14 of
3 chapter 810 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by insert-
4 ing after the line reading "fourth district court of Bristol"
5 the following line: — district court of Franklin.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 78 of said chap-
2 ter 218, as appearing in section 16 of said chapter 810, is here-
3 by amended by striking out the following line: — district
4 court of Franklin.

1 SECTION 3. Paragraph (1) of section 79 of chapter 218,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 701 of the acts of 1964,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out in Class II, line 3
4 reading "district court of Franklin" and inserting in Class III
5 after line 2 reading "district court of Fitchburg" the following
6 line: — district court of Franklin.
