RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE PRACTISES AND TECHNIQUES EMPLOYED BY CANDY MAKERS AND MANUFACTURERS IN WRAPPING CANDY.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-  
3 sentatives, one member of the consumers council, and two  
4 persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established  
5 for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative  
6 to the practises and techniques employed by candy makers  
7 and manufacturers in wrapping candy and whether or not  
8 the same is misleading to the purchasers.
