By Mr. Manning of Waltham, petition of Donald J. Manning for legislation to provide for regulating the retirement allowances of public employees in accordance with the cost-of-living index issued by the Federal Government. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of chapter thirty-
2 two of the General Laws, the retirement allowance of any em-
3 ployee retired from the service of the state, county, city or town
4 on or after January second, nineteen hundred and sixty-five and
5 who is a member of a contributory retirement system shall
6 annually, have his retirement allowance increased by the same
7 percentage as the increase in the official cost of living index
8 issued by the United States government. Such review and
9 change shall be made annually.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on its passage.
