AN ACT REQUIRING THE PAYMENT OF A FILING FEE BY ANY PERSON FILING A PETITION FOR THE PASSAGE OF A BILL OR RESOLVE, OR FOR LEGISLATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any
2 person who files a petition for the passage of a bill or resolve,
3 or for legislation, shall pay a filing fee of one dollar with each
4 petition so filed, the same to be paid to the clerk of the house
5 of representatives or the clerk of the senate.
