RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE DISPLAYING OF FLAGS FROM THE STATE HOUSE DURING THE VIETNAM CONFLICT.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-  
2 bers of the senate, three members of the house of representatives,  
3 and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby  
4 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study  
5 of the subject matter of current house document numbered 1684,  
6 for the display of flags from the state house during the Vietnam  
7 conflict.
