AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE AUTHENTICATION OF THE CONTENTS OF BUSINESS CERTIFICATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 110 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 63 of the acts of 1959, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sen-
4 tence:— In addition thereto the clerk shall require each such
5 person to present evidence satisfactory to him in order to verify
6 the authenticity of the names and addresses appearing in said
7 certificate.
