## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN SKATING RINK IN THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE SERGEANT PETER JOSEPH KELLY SKATING RINK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The metropolitan district commission skating rink at the  
2 corner of Willow Pond parkway and Jamaica way in the city  
3 of Boston shall be designated and known as the Sergeant Peter  
4 Joseph Kelly Skating Rink, and said commission shall erect  
5 thereon and thereafter maintain a suitable marker bearing said  
6 designation.
