AN ACT PROHIBITING THE PAYMENT OF FEES BY MOTOR CARRIERS TO BROKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 159B of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the third paragraph, as amended by
3 section 2 of chapter 543 of the acts of 1959, and inserting in
4 place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 The department shall from time to time establish reasonable
6 maximum fees which shall be paid by the shipper. No broker
7 shall charge a fee for services as a broker to any motor carrier,
8 nor shall any motor carrier pay any fee for services as a broker
9 to any broker.
